Danger ZONE – when bad stuff happens to the aging person – falls, medication mishaps, accidents, wondering. The portion highlighted in **RED** reflects the difference between the person's level of functionality (or lack of functionality) and the level of care they should receive. That difference in the care levels (needed and provided) is the **DANGER ZONE**.
